AMENET's OBJECTIVES:

This project has been conceived to achieve three objectives. First, to identify the main trends of the evolution of the economic integration of the EU. Second, to learn from the European integration process and Third, to reflect the main teachings of the EU that are of interest to the regional integration of the African, Mediterranean, and European economies (AME) and the economic development of Africa.

11. Monetary integration of Africa.
12. Security, Politics, Geostrategic and Peace.
13. Regional Economy in globalization context: regions/cities around the Mediterranean and Africa.
